1 Response to PCC doc 6th Jan.

- The boundary of part of my land (western) which is outlined in LGS 19, adjoins Duchy land as outlined in part of S-001.
- *Within* my land and running parallel with the Duchy land is a strip of woodland, an area of some 1300 m², 13-15m wide and 95m in length. The wooded area is clearly separated from the rest of the field by an established post and rail fence. see figure attached
- The current LGS designation, LGS19, does not differentiate between the field and the woodland area. I believe it is wrong not to do so.
- This wooded area does not fulfil any of the criteria for a LGS designation. As such we object to decision to its inclusion in LGS19; that area should remain as its original status.
